## Why are the Republicans afraid of more people voting?

MADISON - The will of the people can only prevail through free and fair elections, and that begins with the equal opportunity to vote. The election bills brought to the floor of the Senate today interfere with the freedom to vote, the most basic freedom in our democracy. There is a GOP effort underway, across the nation – and here in Wisconsin - to stop people from voting. Why are the Republicans afraid of more people voting?
