## Rep. Vorpagel Statement on Passage of Local Legislation

**Madison-** State Representative Tyler Vorpagel (R-Plymouth) issued the following regarding the passage of Senate Bill 266 this afternoon as it heads to the Governor's desk for signature.

"After years of working with Road America, our local municipalities, and the Department of Revenue I am pleased that today the Assembly and Senate will send this local legislation I've been working on to the Governor's desk for his signature.

"Road America is a unique experience that you can't find anywhere other than the 27<sup>th</sup> Assembly District in the State of Wisconsin. Allowing them the ability to keep evolving their business supports the local tourism industry. Annually they attract over 800,000 visitors and those visitors and events generate more than \$100 million dollars.

"By allowing Road America to continue operating their business as is, it allows their 11 concession stands on the property to be operated by local groups, including non-profits and local businesses. Their thriving business is a huge economic stimulator for our local economy, and working with them over the past few years to make sure they are able to keep giving back to the community has been an honor.
