## Legislators Introduce "Buy American" Package

Sens. Pfaff, Wirch and Reps. McGuire, Snodgrass, Doyle proudly supporting American job creation

MADISON – Today, Wisconsin legislators, led by Senator Brad Pfaff and Representative Tip McGuire, introduced legislation to ensure that the State of Wisconsin purchases goods that are made in America and in our state.

- LRB-0037/1, the **Buy American Act**, requires that the State of Wisconsin purchase goods that are to the greatest extent possible made in the United States.
- LRB-0038/1 amends Wisconsin's state constitution, which currently requires that stationary purchases be awarded to the lowest bidder. This legislation requires that Wisconsin purchase from the lowest bidder operating in the state, unless no Wisconsin-based companies bid.

"Wisconsin-made products are some of the best in the world," said **Senate lead author Brad Pfaff**, "This legislation will make sure our state government prioritizes the purchase of products made right here at home whenever they're available—strengthening Wisconsin workers and Wisconsin businesses."

"I am proud to introduce the Buy American bill package, which ensures that Wisconsin tax dollars go towards promoting American and Wisconsin job creation," said **Rep. Tip McGuire**, "As we bounce back from the COVID-19 pandemic, now is the right time to invest in policies that will help strengthen and grow our middle class."

"The tax dollars of Wisconsin's hardworking men and women should be used to support Wisconsin, and American, businesses and jobs," said **Sen. Bob Wirch**, "I'm proud to cosponsor these bills to help keep and create family-supporting jobs in our state and country."



"Wisconsin is the largest manufacturer of paper in the nation and the Buy American bill package helps support the mills and people and supply who depend on our consumption for their livelihood.
