Rep. Ramthun: Supporting Legislation for the People

MADISON - State Representative Timothy Ramthun (R-Campbellsport) issued the following statement in response to today's Assembly floor session:

"Today, the Assembly passed approximately 50 focused pieces of legislation. Among those were Assembly Bills 56, 108, and 371, along with a handful of election integrity bills."

"Assembly Bill 56 ties in nicely with the Republican plan to eliminate the archaic personal property tax. Many municipalities, including within the 59th Assembly District, stand to benefit should this bill become law."

"Assembly Bill 108 is the latest piece of legislation to be passed that reflects the Assembly's commitment to effective police reform. This reform increases transparency within law enforcement while also ensuring good officers are protected."

"Assembly Bill 371 enhances the broadband expansion grant program to reflect modern technological standards. This will ensure more and more Wisconsinites are able to be reliably connected with our increasingly digital modern world."

"Lastly, the Assembly passed a handful of needed election integrity bills, including legislation to tighten up the absentee ballot process and increase legal penalties for voter fraud. I was proud to support each of these bills, as each of them support Wisconsinites."
