Rep. Sara Rodriguez: Statement on Assembly Floor Session

MADISON – Today, the Wisconsin State Assembly met in regular session to pass numerous bills designed to distract from the Republican controlled legislature's massive cuts to Governor Evers' proposed K-12 education funding in the budget that will be taken up by the Wisconsin State Legislature in the coming days. In response to today's floor session, Rep. Sara Rodriguez (D-Brookfield) released the following statement:

"As the Assembly turns to Wisconsin's biennial budget, I urge my colleagues on the other side of the aisle to stop playing partisan games and start focusing on what's best for the people of Wisconsin. We have an opportunity to use one-time federal resources to address critical needs in our communities, create new opportunities, and transform our state's future. Over the coming days, I will keep pushing for a budget that creates a brighter future for all Wisconsinites as we continue to bounce back from the COVID-19 pandemic."
