## **Governor Evers Signs Legislature's Budget**

**Madison, WI** – Today, Governor Tony Evers signed the 2021-23 budget into law. After the signing, Representative Rachael Cabral-Guevara (R-Fox Crossing) released the following statement:

"I was pleased to hear the governor took the right action and signed the first bi-partisan budget in over a decade. The governor proposed a budget which drastically increased government spending and raised taxes by over \$1 billion. The legislature presented the governor with a reasonable, responsible budget which invests in Wisconsin's priorities while cutting taxes."

"However, I was disappointed the governor vetoed \$50 million worth of transportation funding for our roads, over half a billion dollars meant for our budget stabilization fund, and intends to veto the elimination of the personal property tax. After hearing from hundreds of folks from our area talk about how these investments and policy changes could help them, it was truly difficult to see those gutted."

"At the end of the day, I was proud to have voted for this budget which invests in essential priorities from healthcare, to K-12 education and transportation. The governor made the right choice by signing it in to law."
