Alderwoman Milele A. Coggs today released the schedule for the 10th annual (2021) **Bronzeville Week** (August 7-14).

Bronzeville Week 2021 takes place from August 7 - 14, with the **HaRUNbee 5K Walk/Run** kicking things off on Saturday, August 7 at 8:30 a.m. **Brunch in Bronzeville** is on Saturday and Sunday (August 7 & 8) from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m., and **We Do It For the Culture: Old School Day Party**, is on Sunday (August 8) from 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. The **Bronzeville Sleepover for Education** starts at 7 p.m. on Sunday and goes until 8 a.m. on Monday, August 9.
