MADISON, WI – Rep. Plumer (R – Lodi) released the following statement in response to projections from the non-partisan Legislative Fiscal Bureau that by mid-2023 Wisconsin will take in \$2.9 billion more than originally anticipated:

"This is fantastic news for Wisconsin. Ending the fiscal biennium with \$3.8 billion in the general fund is a testament to the responsible budgeting of Republican's over the last decade. Governor Evers' last budget proposed raising taxes by over \$1 billion dollars. Instead, we chose to put \$2 billion back into Wisconsinites' pockets through tax cuts and still we are continuing to see record revenue numbers in our state.

"While there are still many unknowns about the 2023-2025 budget cycle, I am hopeful that this windfall will allow us be continue our record of returning more money to Wisconsin taxpayers."
