Wisconsin's '22 Election on National Stage

Another election cycle. Another time in the spotlight for Wisconsin elections.

Two years after Joe Biden narrowly won Wisconsin, the Badger state is again preparing for close elections under the scrutiny of national media, operatives, donors, and political parties.

First up is the special spring election to pick a new Milwaukee mayor after the resignation of now-Ambassador to Luxembourg Tom Barrett.

Acting Mayor Cavalier Johnson, the city council president, and former Ald. Bob Donovan made it out of a seven-way primary. The two will square off in an April 5 general election. Should Johnson win, he would become the city's first elected Black mayor.

Then come the Aug. 9 primaries for the major two fall races: U.S. Senate and governor. The general election is Nov. 8.

A crowded field of Democrats will compete to decide who runs against U.S. Sen. Ron Johnson, R-Oshkosh. The leading candidates are Lt. Gov. Mandela Barnes, Milwaukee Bucks executive (on leave) Alex Lasry, state Treasurer Sarah Godlewski, and Outagamie County Exec. Tom Nelson. Johnson is seeking his third six-year term.

Former GOP Lt. Gov. Rebecca Kleefisch, former U.S. Marine Kevin Nicholson, and Rep. Timothy Ramthun are running for the Republican nomination to challenge Democratic Gov. Tony Evers. Evers, the former state schools superintendent, is seeking his second four-year term.

In addition to governor and U.S. Senate, voters aligned in new districts will pick all 99 members of the Assembly and 17 members of the 33-member state Senate. Both chambers are controlled by Republicans.

Voters also will elect eight members of Congress to two-year terms. But only one of the congressional seats, western Wisconsin's 3rd CD, is a swing seat. Longtime U.S. Rep. Ron Kind, D-La Crosse, is leaving the House, spurring a big-money battle for a seat that will help determine if Democrats maintain control of the chamber.

Kind's 2020 opponent, former Navy SEAL Derrick Van Orden, returns for another bid. Democrats will pick their opponent in a primary featuring state Sen. Brad Pfaff, the former state agriculture secretary, and others. Republicans now control the delegation 5-3.

Other top races will decide if Democrat Josh Kaul gets a second term as attorney general and the state's next lieutenant governor.

Both major parties have multiple candidates considering or running for lieutenant governor, including these legislators: Democratic Reps. David Bowen, of Milwaukee, and Sara Rodriguez, of Brookfield; plus Republican Sens. Pat Testin of Stevens Point; and Roger Roth of Appleton.

Other legislators have declared to run for other offices: Republican Rep. Amy Loudenbeck of Clinton, running for Secretary of State; and Republican Rep. Samantha Kerkman of Salem, who placed second in the primary for Kenosha County executive.


