### **AFFIDAVIT OF TIMOTHY J. MICHELS**

TIMOTHY J. MICHELS, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and states as

follows:

herein.

I. I am an adult individual and have personal knowledge of the facts set forth

2. I am a Republican candidate for Wisconsin Governor.

3. Although I believe that my nomination papers do not contain any material "errors" and are legally sufficient as filed, I am submitting this affidavit, pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code Section EL 2.05(4), to address what is alleged to be an "error." Assuming for the sake of argument that it is an "error," I hereby "correct" it.

4. Section EL 2.05(4) states that any "errors in information contained in a nomination paper, committed by either a signer or a circulator, may be corrected by an affidavit of the circulator, an affidavit of the candidate, or an affidavit of a person who signed the nomination paper. The person giving the correcting affidavit shall have personal knowledge of the correct information and the correcting affidavit shall be filed with the filing officer not later than three calendar days after the applicable statutory due date for the nomination papers."

5. The Wisconsin Elections Commission website states that "the deadline for candidates to file correcting affidavits" is "Monday, June 6 at 4:30 p.m." It explains, "Because the three-day period for filing correcting affidavits and challenges established by Wis. Admin. Code.

EL §§ 2.05(4) and 2.07(2)(a) falls on a Saturday, a day the agency is not scheduled to be open for regular business, Wis. Stat. § 990.001(4)(c) dictates that the Commission must accept the documents on Monday."

6. My campaign is run through Michels for Governor, Inc. (the "Campaign"), a domestic non-stock corporation.

On May 31, 2022, the Campaign submitted 4,000 nomination papers on my 7. behalf.

8. The Wisconsin Elections Commission accepted 3,861 of those signatures as

valid.

9. On June 5, 2022, I learned that, according to the Wisconsin Elections Commission, 345 of the remaining 3,861 signatures were on nomination papers modeled after the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, which contains the phrase "Who resides at 6831 State Road 83, Hartland, WI 53029, in the village of Chenequa" immediately below the name "Tim Michels."

10. Inadvertently, a different nomination form, attached hereto as Exhibit B, was uploaded to the Campaign's webpage for public use and dissemination. This form contains the phrase "Who resides at 6831 State Road 83 in the village of Chenequa," immediately below the name "Tim Michels."

11. The Campaign and I intended that the nomination form attached as Exhibit A be the nomination form used by all circulators and that all nomination forms contain the phrasing "Who resides at 6831 State Road 83, Hartland, WI 53029, in the village of Chenequa" immediately below the name "Tim Michels."

12. A number of circulators inadvertently used the second nomination form attached as Exhibit B.

13. As a result, according to the Wisconsin Election Commission, a total of 3,516 of the 3,861 signatures were on nomination papers modeled after the form attached as Exhibit B.

14. I did not learn that the form attached as Exhibit B was uploaded to the Campaign website and inadvertently used by circulators until after the nomination papers had been submitted to the Wisconsin Elections Commission.

15. I recall that mail addressed to my attention at 6831 State Road 83, Village of Chenequa, has been delivered to me in the past.

16. At no point have I or the Campaign sought to mislead any voters or signatories to my nomination papers about the location of my primary residence.




