Will Radler to Host Second Concert in Bird Songs Series benefitting LuAnn Bird Assembly Campaign

GREENFIELD WI— Will Radler, creator of Knock Out Roses, will be hosting the second installment of the Bird Songs concert series to benefit the campaign of LuAnn Bird for Wisconsin's 84th Assembly District. This concert will be from 6-9pm on September 8th at the Rose Innovations Rosarium located at 10200 W Meadow Drive in Greenfield. All are welcome to join. Musicians Martha Cannon, Joe Crockett, and Chris Porterfield will be performing.
