DEAN MARTIN NEUBERT DECLINES TO FORCE A RECOUNT

[ELLINGTON, WI] Dean Martin Neubert announced that his campaign for the 6th Assembly District, will not be seeking a recount. Although the margin is within his right to do so, he did not want to put the municipal workers and the community through that process.

"I am humbled with the amount of support I have received by so many people in district 6 during and since the primary election. I do not think a recount is necessary at this time," said Dean.
