## ***HER BOLD MOVE* ENDORSES GAGE-MICHAELS IN HISTORIC STATE SENATE RACE**

**DE PERE, WI** —State Senate Candidate Andrea Gage-Michaels is pleased to announce that she's been endorsed by *Her Bold Move*—a new PAC dedicated to electing women to all places where decisions are being made—for her positive, proactive approach to ensuring reproductive justice in Wisconsin and her longstanding record of fighting for women's rights.

Gage-Michaels, an attorney and former Planned Parenthood staffer, is the only pro-choice candidate in Senate District 1 and would be the first woman elected to that seat. Her opponent, Andre Jacque, is one of the most anti-choice legislators in Wisconsin and the nation.

"Her Bold Move is honored to stand by Andrea in this historic and important campaign. It's obvious to us that she has a clear vision for Wisconsin informed by on-the-ground work and conversations with voters. We are grateful for her commitment to advocating for women's rights to reproductive healthcare in particular -- and for her strong and impressive record on women's issues. We couldn't be more excited to see what she is able to accomplish next."

Gage-Michaels is a staunch proponent of repealing Wisconsin's criminal abortion ban, an antiquated law that has remained on the books since 1849. That pre-Civil War era statute would make doctors who perform the procedure Class H felons, and contains no exception for rape and incest. Gage-Michaels also played a major role in the passage of the Compassionate Care for Rape Victims Bill in 2008, which requires that all Wisconsin hospital emergency rooms provide medical accurate information about emergency contraception (EC) to sexual assault victims, and dispense EC upon request.

"As someone who has worked in health care advocacy and in the courts, I have extensive knowledge in making sure every voice is heard in every place where decisions are being made. That's why I'm so honored to have the support of Her Bold Move," said Gage-Michaels. "We must ensure that women have continued access to the health care they need so they can meaningfully participate in our society and economy. 2022 may be the year that Roe fell, but it will also be the year that we reclaim bodily autonomy for all."
