Jan. 6 Watch Party in Madison at Hawk's Bar & Grill Oct 13, 12:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m., 425 State St. We Demand Accountability for Wis. Accomplices in the Coup Attempt!

MADISON, WI—Five pro-democracy groups are co-sponsoring a watch party for the final hearing of the Jan. 6 Committee this Thursday, Oct. 13.

The event will be held at Hawk's Bar & Grill in Madison at 425 State St., starting at noon, and it's open to the public.

The co-sponsors are the League of Women Voters of Wisconsin (Dane County chapter), the Service Employees International Union, Souls to the Polls, the Wisconsin Democracy Campaign, and Working Families Power.

The groups are demanding accountability for the Wisconsin accomplices in the Jan. 6 seditious conspiracy and coup attempt.

Those accomplices include Wisconsin's 10 false electors, the 15 Republican legislators who signed a letter to Vice President Pence on Jan. 5 urging him not to certify the election, and Sen. Ron Johnson, who tried to deliver the slate of false electors to Pence on Jan. 6 just minutes before the start of the Electoral College vote count.

"Jan. 6 was the gravest threat to our democracy in our lifetimes, and the Wisconsinites who participated in this grave criminal conspiracy must be held accountable," says Matt Rothschild, the executive director of the Wisconsin Democracy Campaign. "We can't ever let something like this happen again, and the best way to ensure that it doesn't is to prosecute those individuals, including those right here in Wisconsin, who engaged in this plot against America."
