The average price received by farmers for **corn** during October 2022 in Wisconsin was \$5.99 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was \$1.13 below the September price but \$1.20 above October 2021.

The October 2022 average price received by farmers for **soybeans**, at \$13.20 per bushel, was 90 cents below the September price but \$1.40 above the October 2021 price.

The October average **oat** price per bushel, at \$4.47, was 6 cents below September but 43 cents above October 2021.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$149.00 per ton in October. This was \$5.00 above the September price but \$2.00 below the October 2021 price. The October 2022 **alfalfa hay** price, at \$169.00, was \$8.00 above the previous month and \$5.00 above October 2021. The average price received for **other hay** during October was \$105.00 per ton. This was \$9.00 above the September price but \$5.00 below October last year.

The average price for **milk** was \$24.40 per cwt, \$2.30 above the September price and \$4.70 above October 2021.
