JUDGE DOROW'S CAMPAIGN FOR SUPREME COURT RAISES OVER \$300,000 IN JUST 30 DAYS

Waukesha, Wis. (January 17, 2023) – Despite only being in the race for a month, Judge Jennifer Dorow's campaign announced today that it raised \$306,919 in the 30 days following her announcing her candidacy for Wisconsin Supreme Court. The campaign also announced an overwhelming 96 percent of the donations she received were from Wisconsinites.

"I couldn't be more humbled by the support I've received in such a short period of time," said Judge Dorow. "As I have traveled the state over the last six weeks, it's clear most Wisconsinites understand the incredible stakes of this election, and they want a Supreme Court Justice who is committed to upholding the rule of law. That's exactly what I've done in my 11 years as a judge and exactly what I'll do as a Supreme Court Justice."

Despite entering the race many months after the other candidates, Judge Dorow's campaign has received widespread support in a short period of time. She's been endorsed by Justice Pat Roggensack, the woman she is seeking to succeed, and former Justice Jon Wilcox. Earlier this week, Mike Grebe, one of the most prominent figures in conservative legal circles in the state, announced his endorsement. Judge Dorow also has the support of more law enforcement leaders than any other candidate in the race. Her endorsements include the Milwaukee Police Association, the Waukesha Police Chiefs Association, Fond du Lac County District Attorney and President of the Wisconsin District Attorney's Association Eric Toney, and 38 bi-partisan Wisconsin sheriffs.

Judge Dorow, who is Chief Judge for the Third Judicial District, has been on the bench for 11 years. She was recently chosen by her peers to serve as Chief of the Chief Judges. Prior to becoming a judge, she worked as an attorney in the Waukesha County District Attorney's office and in private practice. Her husband, Brian, served in various capacities in law enforcement, and they have three children.
