The average price received by farmers for **corn** during July 2023 in Wisconsin was \$6.16 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was 8 cents below the June price and 63 cents below July 2022.

The July 2023 average price received by farmers for **soybeans**, at \$14.70 per bushel, was 80 cents above the June price but 50 cents below the July 2022 price.

The July average **oat** price per bushel, at \$3.62, was 59 cents below June and \$1.44 below July 2022.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$140.00 per ton in July. This was \$11.00 below the June price but \$6.00 above the July 2022 price. The July 2023 **alfalfa hay** price, at \$150.00, was \$5.00 below the previous month but \$6.00 above July 2022. The average price received for **other hay** during July was \$117.00 per ton. This was \$10.00 below the June price but \$13.00 above July last year.

The average price for **milk** was \$15.50 per cwt, 70 cents below the June price and \$8.90 below July 2022.

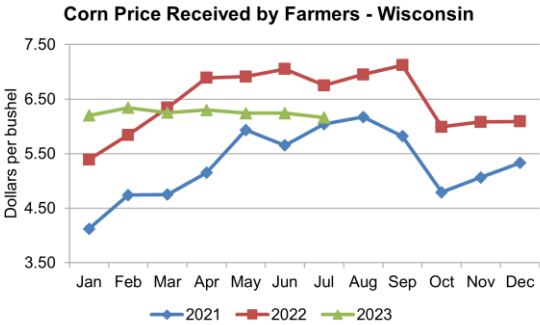
