State Senate Approves Governor Evers' Legislative Maps

Madison- Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu (R-Oostburg) issued the following statement regarding today's floor action:

"The liberal majority of the Wisconsin Supreme Court has made it clear that its primary objective is to benefit legislative Democrats to the greatest extent possible.

"Given the current circumstance, the legislature is faced with two choices: either pass the Governor's maps and have them signed into law or allow the liberal Wisconsin Supreme Court to unilaterally gerrymander the state.

"Wisconsin voters deserve certainty. Rather than let out-of-state 'experts' gerrymander the state on the eve of the 2024 election, the legislature took action today to preserve Wisconsinites' faith in their state government.
