SENATOR ERIC WIMBERGER ANNOUNCES SENATE DISTRICT 2 CANDIDACY TO CONTINUE EFFECTIVE REPRESENTATION FOR HIS CONSTITUENTS

After a district remapping that reformed the 30th Senate District into an eclectic mix of various districts in the area, including dividing a large portion of it into the new 2nd District, State Senator Eric Wimberger announces his candidacy for the 2nd Senate District.

“I’m excited about the opportunity to be the conservative voice for my current constituents and new constituents in Northeast Wisconsin. From the north of the district near my family’s small business, to the very south where the first generation of Wimbergers immigrated to a Kaukauna farm, I have strong vested ties to the area.” Wimberger said.

Senator Wimberger championed critical legislation to the 2nd Senate District including obtaining funds and drafting legislation to help remediate PFAS contamination in both rural and urban areas, and securing funding for the Southern Bridge in Brown County which will transform the area and create opportunity.

Wimberger said “I look forward to continuing my effective representation as the Legislative Audit Committee Chairman doing government oversight, and as a member of the Joint Finance Committee organizing the state budget. I’ll also have an opportunity to live closer to the family business, Sweet Memories Candy Shoppe in Lakewood, and help my mom in our 35th year open.”

Eric Wimberger was born and raised in the Green Bay area. After high school, he attended St. Cloud State University. Graduating with a B.A. in criminal justice. He then drove an orange semi-truck long haul before enrolling at Marquette University Law School.

With his Juris Doctor, Eric commissioned in the USMC as a Judge Advocate and honed his legal skills. He was stationed mostly in Japan and Washington D.C., honorably discharging as a Captain. Home in 2010, Eric opened his law practice.

Elected to the State Senate in 2020, Eric chairs the Audit Committee conducting all government oversight for the Legislature. He also sits on the Joint Finance Committee drafting the state budget, the Judiciary Committee, Uniform Law Commission, Law Revision Committee, and Claims Board.

Accomplishments include obtaining funds to build the Southern Bridge, drafting the PFAS remediation bill and obtaining the funding to help with cleanup, and authoring the Constitutional amendment to stop Zuckerbucks.
