Senate Has Confirmed 96.1% of Governor Evers' Appointments

Madison- Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu issued the following statement regarding the Senate's action in the advice and consent process:

"The Senate takes its role in the advice and consent process seriously. Appointments must prove that they are qualified, capable, and that they will follow the law in their capacities.

"573 of Governor Evers' appointees have met that standard, 23 did not."

82 appointments have not been considered on the floor of the Senate this session. A similar number of appointments have been left outstanding at the end of each legislative session since the 2015-16 session when the Senate did not take action as a body on 52 of Governor Walker's appointments.
