Patti Granger Announces Run for 13th District Assembly Seat

Wauwatosa, WI – Patti Granger of Wauwatosa announced today she will run in the Republican Primary for State Assembly in the newly formed 13th District, which covers part of Wauwatosa, Brookfield, and Elm Grove. The primary for state elected offices will be held in August with the general election in November. She released the following statement:

How did her run start? A few years ago, a neighbor, who walked by her house almost every night asking her "So, when are you running?" planted the seed for her to run for State Assembly. And now, here we are!

"We need to bring conservatism into the 21st century. This means being a logical thinker. Setting aside your feelings, sometimes having tough love, and understanding how trendy social agendas can have long lasting negative impacts on a community. While keeping the Republican base, I'm also here to inspire and encourage a new generation. I feel if people ages 18-30 can see my boys and me, know what we stand for, then maybe they might get inspired and want to be part of the GOP, join the conservative movement and vote for me too." Patti graduated from the Milwaukee School of Art and Design with a B.F.A in Sculpture. After adopting her first son, she returned to school earning an M.B.A from Mount Mary University. She took 36 straight classes and graduated with a 4.0 GPA. It was here she found her passion for Improving Processes, Lean, Six Sigma, and Continuous Improvement. She now works full time doing just that for a fortune 500 company in Milwaukee, WI.
