General Mike Flynn, Close Associate of President Trump, Joins Vos Recall Effort

Union Grove, WI - May 18, 2024 - General Mike Flynn, former National Security Advisor under President Trump, urges residents of Wisconsin Assembly District 63 to sign the recall petition aiming to recall Assembly Speaker Robin Vos. Flynn warns that Robin Vos's connections to Communist China pose a danger to Wisconsin and the USA.

In a video spreading on X (formerly Twitter), (here: https://x.com/racinerecall/status/1791957837670695110?s=46&t=BZxzR8S8GEYLLGXHGf1_lw) Flynn states that Vos "...has blocked vital legislation, like AB269, which would restrict Communist China from purchasing Wisconsin farmland." Vos is the vice-chair of an organization called the State Legislative Leadership Foundation (SLLF), which has a permanent partnership with the Chinese People's Association of Friendship with Foreign Countries (CPAFFC). The CPAFFC has been identified by the US State Department as a Chinese Communist Party (CCP) front group. Mike Pompeo, while US Secretary of State under President Trump, came to Madison, Wisconsin, in 2020 to warn of the dangers of accepting trips and gifts from the Chinese friendship groups.

Flynn claims that, despite these warnings, Vos accepted trips and gifts from the CPAFFC funneled through the SLLF.

General Flynn joined Wisconsin conservatives last week in signing a letter calling for the recall of Vos. The video represents an escalation in involvement from associates of former President Trump. MyPillow CEO Mike Lindell has been involved in the recall from the beginning and is joined by retired Army Colonel Conrad Reynolds, an election security advocate and host of 'The Colonel of Truth.'
