Vos Wrong- Sufficient Signatures Confirmed to Force Recall of Robin Vos

Union Grove, WI - June 10, 2024 - The Racine Recall Committee has reviewed the challenges made by Robin Vos to the recall petition signatures and has found them to be insufficient. Despite Vos's efforts, he and his team could not reduce the total number of signatures below the required 6,850. Instead, they resorted to smear tactics to deny the constitutional rights of his constituents.

Our daily signature validation efforts have confirmed that we have well more than the required 6,850 valid signatures to trigger a recall election. Despite the challenges from Vos's team, our thorough verification process proves we remain above the threshold, ensuring a recall election will be held.

In some instances where Vos alleged fraud, it was discovered that a wife had signed for her husband, who has Parkinson's disease. This attempt to label law-abiding citizens as fraudulent is a clear strategy to disenfranchise the voters of his district.

Furthermore, Vos's argument that he cannot be recalled from District 63 due to remapping and changing to a new district in 2025 directly contradicts the constitutional rights of his constituents.

Another challenge Vos made was that signatures were collected past the deadline (60th day). However, the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) has confirmed to the Racine Recall Committee that collecting signatures on days 61 and 62 of the recall was permitted.

Our daily count of eligible signatures immediately identified the errors in Vos's challenges, reinforcing our confidence in the validity of our petition. With no specific challenges to signatures that would bring the total below the threshold, the WEC must verify our petition and proceed to schedule the recall election.

The Racine Recall Committee will hold a press conference on the afternoon of Tuesday, the 11th. Former Wisconsin Supreme Court Justice Michael Gableman will be joined by Racine Recall Committee lawyer Kevin Scott to address these developments. Time and location to be determined.
