Building Trades Gather In Support Of We Energies Proposed Oak Creek Natural Gas Plant

OAK CREEK, WI – Members of the Milwaukee Building & Construction Trades Council, AFL-CIO (MBCTC) will gather in support of the proposed Oak Creek Power Plant on **Tuesday, March 25, 2025, at 11:30 AM at the Oak Creek Community Center** (8580 South Howell Avenue, Oak Creek, WI 53154).

The gathering will take place ahead of the 1:00 PM public hearing on the project and will feature remarks from leaders from Milwaukee's building trades unions. Wisconsin union workers are in full support of this project and have submitted more than 4,000 comments in support to the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin.

This new power plant, proposed by We Energies, will play a crucial role in providing reliable, around-the-clock energy for Wisconsin residents while creating up to 800 jobs during peak construction activity.
