Committee Motions for April 24, 2025 Executive Session:

## Clearinghouse Rule 24-032: Wisconsin Elections Commission - Conduct, regulation, and accommodation of election observers

 Moved, that the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules, pursuant to s. 227.19 (5) (d), Stats., object to Clearinghouse Rule 24-032, relating to conduct, regulation, and accommodation of election observers (Wisconsin Elections Commission), on the grounds that the proposed rule fails to comply with legislative intent.

## Clearinghouse Rule 24-043: Wisconsin Elections Commission - Certification and training of municipal clerks

• Moved, that the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules, pursuant to s. 227.19 (5) (b) 2., Stats., requests that the Wisconsin Elections Commission consider modifications to Clearinghouse Rule 24-043, relating to certification and training of municipal clerks; and, if the commission does not provide written acceptance of the request to consider modifications, delivered to the Committee Co-Chairs by 4:30 p.m. on April 25, 2025, that, pursuant to s. 227.19 (5) (d), Stats., the Committee objects to Clearinghouse Rule 24-043, on the grounds that there has been a change in circumstances since enactment of the earliest law upon which the proposed rule is based.

## **Emergency Rule 2411: Pharmacy Examining Board – Controlled Substances Requirements**

• Moved, that the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules, pursuant to s. 227.24 (2), Stats., extend the effective period of an emergency rule of the Pharmacy Examining Board, relating to controlled substances requirements (EmR 2411 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Ext.), for a period of 60 days through June 27, 2025.
