Senator Habush Sinykin Applauds Governor Evers' Final State of the State Address

MADISON, WI – This evening, State Senator Jodi Habush Sinykin (D-Whitefish Bay) attended Governor Evers' 8th and final State of the State address. During the address, Governor Evers declared 2026 "The Year of the Neighbor," calling on Wisconsinites to lean into their community connections and our shared Wisconsin values.
