Lazar Campaign Launches “It’s Just Not Fair” Ad, Highlighting Chris Taylor’s Radical Record on Fringe Issues

[Waukesha, Wis] — Today, the Judge Maria Lazar campaign for the Wisconsin Supreme Court released its newest statewide advertisement, “[It’s Just Not Fair.](#)” The ad, [available here](#), directly targets activist judge Chris Taylor’s history of prioritizing fringe ideology over the common-sense protections that Wisconsin families and female athletes rely on.

Building on the campaign’s momentum, “It’s Just Not Fair” highlights a fundamental concern for Wisconsin parents: the erosion of fair competition in girls’ sports. The ad contrasts Judge Lazar’s commitment to the rule of law with Chris Taylor’s record of siding with radical interests that would allow biological boys to compete in girls’ athletic programs.

“Wisconsin families know that it’s just not fair for our daughters and granddaughters to be pushed off the podium by biological males,” said campaign spokesperson Nathan Conrad. “While activist judge Chris Taylor sides with a fringe ideology that ignores basic fairness, Judge Maria Lazar stands for the rule of law. Maria will protect our families, our kids, and the opportunities our girls have worked so hard to earn.”

“It’s Just Not Fair” emphasizes these core contrasts:

- **Protecting Girls’ Sports:** Contrasts Maria Lazar’s dedication to maintaining a fair and level playing field for female athletes with Chris Taylor’s alignment with radical groups that seek to redefine girls’ sports.
- **Family First vs. Fringe Ideology:** Highlights Lazar’s role as a defender of the law and the family unit, whereas Taylor has consistently used her platform to advance an activist agenda that puts Madison politics ahead of Wisconsin kids.
- **The Rule of Law:** Reaffirms that Judge Lazar will interpret the law as written, ensuring that the judicial system protects the rights of parents and the safety of children, rather than legislating from the bench.
