## **DANNY DAY ENDORSES JOHN GSCHIEDMEIER FOR WAUKESHA COUNTY SHERIFF**

**WAUKESHA, Wis.** — John G. Gscheidmeier, Republican candidate for Waukesha County Sheriff, today announced the endorsement of retired FBI Assistant Special Agent in Charge Danny Day. Day spent more than 25 years with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, leading major criminal, intelligence, counterterrorism, and national security investigations before rising to Special Agent in Charge. He is widely respected throughout the law enforcement community as a leader and mentor.

Day was himself a candidate for Waukesha County Sheriff earlier this year before stepping away from the race for personal and health reasons. Rather than step back from the fight for the department's future, Day is now backing Gscheidmeier's campaign.

Day joins retired Milwaukee Police Chief Alfonso Morales in endorsing Gscheidmeier. Both men have pledged to help Gscheidmeier win in August and to work alongside him after the election to restore professionalism, leadership, and collaboration within the Sheriff's Department.

The endorsement adds to a growing coalition of law enforcement professionals, elected officials, and community leaders backing Gscheidmeier ahead of the August 11 Republican primary.
