Rep. Calvin Callahan Announces Campaign for Re-Election

Representative Calvin Callahan announces today he is running for Re-Election to the Wisconsin State Assembly. Calvin came to you seven years ago with a vision that families should be able to afford to live where they love, right here in the Northwoods. During this last session, Calvin has made tremendous strides toward that vision. He was proud to author, co-author, and vote for:

Focusing on Affordability: Representative Callahan played a pivotal role in reversing Governor Evers' proposed \$3.7 billion tax hike and successfully securing a \$1.5 billion tax cut for Wisconsinites. He also voted to end taxes on tips, overtime, utilities, and to reverse the Governor's 400-year school funding increase.

Protecting our Communities: He fought to pass legislation that enables law enforcement to pursue criminals who use cryptocurrency, social media, and other modern platforms to defraud Wisconsinites, groom minors, and target our vulnerable populations.

Fighting for Sporting Heritage: Representative Callahan pushed for the implementation of a wolf population goal and a wolf hunting season. He also fought against legislation that would infringe on your Second Amendment right.

Fixing our Healthcare System: He supported key healthcare reforms including bills to increase price transparency, extend postpartum coverage, create discounts for timely payment, and expand access to cancer screenings.

Delivering Efficient Government: Representative Callahan was a key supporter for bills aimed to make our state government more transparent, efficient, and accountable to the people of Wisconsin. He authored AB 277 to reduce the cost of regulations and put a stop to endless expansion of bureaucratic red tape.

Increased Funding for Local Projects: He secured \$1 million for local meat processors, supported agriculture and forestry, and delivered \$1.1 billion in road funding including \$150 million for the Agricultural Roads Improvement Program to improve highways like 107, 17, 45, and others in our area. For rural families, Calvin increased childcare assistance using existing federal funds and launched a school readiness program. He also passed legislation providing over \$130 million for PFAS cleanup while protecting innocent landowners.

Calvin will continue to demand fiscal responsibility and fight for our vision. He will cut taxes, stand up for our sporting heritage, fight for our fair share of funding, and fight for our Northwoods values.
