Emily Berge Launches District Tour on First Day of Nomination Signature Collection

Eau Claire, WI — Emily Berge, candidate for Congress in Wisconsin’s 3rd Congressional District, will kick off the first day of nomination paper circulation on Wednesday, April 15th with a 5 stop day of action.
